Active Judo upholds the principle that all children, whatever their age, culture, disability, gender, language, racial origin, religious belief and/or sexual identity have the right to protection from abuse.

The members, coaches and volunteers of Active Judo are committed to the welfare and protection of children and young people, so that they can enjoy activities in safety without fear, threat or abuse.

Active Judo adopts SAFELANDINGS, the official child protection policies and procedures of our National Governing Body, JudoScotland.

Any volunteers working within the club environment are required to adhere to the following procedures:

- Enhanced Disclosure (PVG)
- Formal Interview
- Attend Safeguarding & Child Protection Workshop
- Signed Individual Job Description & Code of Conduct (Highlighting the club's child protection & equality procedures and candidates roles and responsibilities)
- References

The implementation of these procedures will be reviewed regularly and monitored by the club committee.
